1-21 relating to the confidentiality of fraud detection and deterrence
 1-22 and counterterrorism information under the public information law.
 1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
 1-24 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 552, Government Code, is
 1-25 amended by adding Section 552.163 to read as follows:
 1-26 Sec. 552.163. EXCEPTION: CONFIDENTIALITY OF INFORMATION
 1-27 REGARDING FRAUD DETECTION AND DETERRENCE MEASURES AND
 1-28 COUNTERTERRORISM MEASURES. Information in the custody of a
 1-29 governmental body that relates to fraud detection and deterrence
 1-30 measures or counterterrorism measures is confidential and excepted
 1-31 from the requirements of Section 552.021.
 1-32 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
