8	OFFICERS. The comptroller shall ensure that a security officer or
9	investigator commissioned as a peace officer by the comptroller is
10	compensated according to Schedule C of the position classification
11	salary schedule prescribed by the General Appropriations Act.
12	SECTION 2. Section 661.918(a), Government Code, is amended
13	to read as follows:
14	(a) This section applies to a peace officer under Article
15	2.12, Code of Criminal Procedure, who is commissioned as a law
16	enforcement officer or agent, including a ranger, by:
17	(1) the Public Safety Commission and the director of
18	the Department of Public Safety;
19	(2) the Parks and Wildlife Commission;
20	(3) the Texas Alcoholic Beverage Commission;
21	(4) the attorney general; [or]
22	(5) the insurance fraud unit of the Texas Department

(6) the comptroller.

- 2 the state auditor shall classify the position of commissioned peace
- 3 officer employed by the comptroller of public accounts of the State
- 4 of Texas as a Schedule C position under the position classification
- 5 plan maintained under Chapter 654, Government Code.
- 6 (b) The change made by the classification officer as
- 7 required by this section applies beginning with the state fiscal
- 8 biennium beginning September 1, 2023.
- 9 (c) This section expires September 1, 2025.
- SECTION 4. Section 661.918(a), Government Code, as amended
- 11 by this Act, applies only to an injury that occurs on or after the
- 12 effective date of this Act.
- SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
