- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 20.05(a), Penal Code, is amended to read
- 5 as follows:
- 6 (a) A person commits an offense if the person knowingly:
- 7 (1) uses a motor vehicle, aircraft, watercraft, or
- 8 other means of conveyance to transport an individual with the
- 9 intent to:
- 10 (A) conceal the individual from a peace officer
- 11 or special investigator; or
- 12 (B) flee from a person the actor knows is a peace
- 13 officer or special investigator attempting to lawfully arrest or
- 14 detain the actor;
- 15 (2) encourages or induces a person to enter or remain
- 16 in this country in violation of federal law by concealing,
- 17 harboring, or shielding that person from detection; or
- 18 (3) assists, guides, or directs two or more
- 19 individuals to enter or remain on agricultural land or in a public
- 20 park or recreational area without the effective consent of the
- 21 owner.
- 22 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 23 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.

- 1 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed,
- 2 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
- 3 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
- 4 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred
- 5 before that date.
- 6 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
