- 6 SECTION 1. Section 92.0563(e), Property Code, is amended to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 (e) A justice court may not award a judgment under this
- 9 section, including an order of repair, that exceeds \$20,000
- 10 [\$10,000], excluding interest and costs of court.
- 11 SECTION 2. Section 92.0563(e), Property Code, as amended by
- 12 this Act, applies only to a cause of action that accrues on or after
- 13 the effective date of this Act. A cause of action that accrues
- 14 before that date is governed by the law in effect immediately before
- 15 that date, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
