- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter F, Chapter 301, Government Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 301.073 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 301.073. SUBSTITUTE TEACHING REQUIREMENT. (a) Each
- 8 member of the senate and the house of representatives shall
- 9 substitute teach at a public school located in the member's
- 10 district for at least one school day each school year.
- 11 (b) Each member shall report the member's compliance with
- 12 Subsection (a) to the senate or house committee on administration,
- 13 <u>as applicable. Each committee shall maintain a list of the members</u>
- 14 in the committee's respective house who do not meet the
- 15 requirements of this section. The list is public information under
- 16 Chapter 552.
- 17 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply
- 18 beginning with the 2023-2024 school year.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
