A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT relating to the punishment for the criminal offense of operation of 2 a stash house; increasing a criminal penalty. 3 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. Section 20.07(b), Penal Code, is amended to read 5 6 as follows: (b) An offense under this section is a felony of the third 7 8 degree, except that the offense is a felony of the second degree if it is shown on the trial of the offense that as a direct result of 9 10 the commission of the offense: (1) an individual became a victim of sexual assault, 11 as defined by Section 22.011, or aggravated sexual assault, as 12 defined by Section 22.021; or 13 14 (2) an individual suffered serious bodily injury or 15 death [Class A misdemeanor]. SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only 16 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. 17 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is 18 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed, 19 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For the 20 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the 21 22 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred before that date. 23

24 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
