Subchapter A, Chapter 46B, Code of Criminal 7 Procedure, is amended by adding Article 46B.014 to read as follows: Art. 46B.014. TRANSFER TO COMMISSION; COMPENSATION TO 8 9 COUNTIES. (a) The commission shall take custody of a defendant awaiting transfer under an order issued under Article 46B.073 to a 10 facility operated by or under contract with the commission, not 11 12 later than the 45th day following the date the order is issued. (b) If the commission does not take custody of a defendant 13 14 within the period prescribed by Subsection (a), the commission shall compensate the county for the cost of confinement for each day 15 16 that the defendant remains confined in the county jail following the expiration of that period. The compensation must be equal to 17 the amount that would have been incurred by the commission to 18 confine the defendant for that period. 19 SECTION 2. Article 46B.014, Code of Criminal Procedure, as 20
