A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the purchase and sale of vintage distilled spirits by
3	the holder of a package store permit or local distributor's permit.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 1.04, Alcoholic Beverage Code, is
6	amended by adding subdivisions (30) and (31) to read as follows:
7	(30) "Vintage distilled spirits" means alcohol, spirits of
8	wine, whiskey, rum, brandy, gin, or any liquor produced in whole or
9	in part by the process of distillation, including all dilutions or
10	mixtures of them, and are:
11	(A) a bottle or case of bottles of distilled spirits
12	that:
13	(1) are in their original manufacturer's
14	unopened container;
15	(2) are not owned by the holder of a distiller's
16	and rectifier's permit or a nonresident seller's permit;
17	(3) are not otherwise available for purchase from
18	or have been offered for sale by the holder of a wholesaler's permit
19	in this state within the last twelve (12) months; and
20	(4) are possessed in this state.
21	(31) A "vintage distilled spirits seller" means a
22	non-licensed person at least twenty-one (21) years of age who is:
23	(A) an administrator, executor, receiver, or other
2/1	fiduciary who receives and sells vintage distilled spirits in

- 1 execution of the person's fiduciary capacity;
- 2 (B) a creditor who receives or takes possession of
- 3 vintage distilled spirits as security for, or in payment of, debt,
- 4 in whole or in part;
- 5 (C) a public officer or court official who levies on
- 6 vintage distilled spirits under order or process of any court or
- 7 magistrate to sell the vintage distilled spirits in satisfaction of
- 8 the order or process; or
- 9 (D) any other person who is not a permittee or
- 10 licensee, holds no interest in a permittee or licensee, and is not
- 11 engaged in the business of selling alcoholic beverages.
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 22.01, Alcoholic Beverage Code, is
- 13 amended to read as follows:
- 14 Sec. Sec. 22.01. AUTHORIZED ACTIVITIES. The holder of a
- 15 package store permit may:
- 16 (1) purchase liquor in this state from the holder of a
- 17 winery, wholesaler's, or class B wholesaler's permit;
- 18 (2) purchase malt beverages in this state from the holder of
- 19 a general or branch distributor's license;
- 20 (2-a) purchase vintage distilled spirits from a vintage
- 21 distilled spirits seller;
- 22 (3) sell liquor and malt beverages in unbroken original
- 23 containers on or from the holder's licensed premises at retail to
- 24 consumers for off-premises consumption only and not for the purpose
- 25 of resale, except that if the permittee is a hotel, the permittee
- 26 may deliver unbroken packages of liquor and malt beverages to bona
- 27 fide guests of the hotel in their rooms for consumption in their

- 1 rooms;
- 2 (4) sell vinous liquors in original containers of not less
- 3 than six ounces; [and]
- 4 (5) sell liquor to holders of passenger transportation
- 5 permits as provided in Section 48.03; and
- 6 (6) sell vintage distilled spirits as provided in Section
- 7 22.19.
- 8 SECTION 3. Chapter 22, Alcoholic Beverage Code, is amended
- 9 by adding Section 22.19 to read as follows:
- 10 Sec. 22.19. PURCHASE AND SALE OF VINTAGE DISTILLED SPIRITS.
- 11 <u>(a) The holder of a package store permit may purchase</u>
- 12 vintage distilled spirits from a vintage distilled spirits seller.
- 13 (b) A vintage distilled spirits seller may sell no more than
- 14 twenty-four (24) vintage distilled spirits bottles or containers in
- 15 any given twelve (12) month period to each premises of the holder of
- 16 <u>a package store permit.</u>
- 17 (c) Prior to selling vintage distilled spirits purchased
- 18 from a vintage distilled spirits seller to a consumer, the holder of
- 19 a package store permit shall provide notice of its purchase of the
- 20 vintage distilled spirits to the commission. The notice shall
- 21 contain the following information:
- 22 (1) the name, address, state license number, and phone
- 23 number of the holder of a package store permit purchasing vintage
- 24 distilled spirits;
- 25 (2) the name, address, and phone number of the vintage
- 26 distilled spirits seller;
- 27 (3) the brand name and quantity of bottles or

- 1 containers of each vintage distilled spirits purchased;
- 2 <u>(4)</u> the date of the purchase; and
- 3 (5) the number of bottles or containers that the
- 4 package store permittee has previously purchased from the same
- 5 vintage distilled spirits seller and the dates of those purchases.
- 6 SECTION 4. Chapter 23, Alcoholic Beverage Code, is amended
- 7 by amending Section 23.01 by adding subdivision (c) to read as
- 8 follows:
- 9 (c) A local distributor's permittee may purchase vintage
- 10 distilled spirits from a vintage distilled spirits seller subject
- 11 to the same limitations and requirements under Section 22.19(b) and
- 12 (c). A local distributor's permittee may sell and distribute such
- 13 vintage distilled spirits to the mixed beverage permittees in an
- 14 amount not to exceed six (6) bottles or containers per mixed
- 15 beverage permittee premises during any given twelve (12) month
- 16 period.
- 17 SECTION 5. Subsection (a), Section 28.07, Alcoholic
- 18 Beverage Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 19 (a) All distilled spirits and vintage distilled spirits
- 20 sold by a holder of a mixed beverage permit must be purchased from a
- 21 holder of a local distributor's permit in the county in which the
- 22 premises of a mixed beverage permittee is located.
- 23 SECTION 6. Section 201.02, Alcoholic Beverage Code, is
- 24 amended to read as follows:
- Sec. 201.02. "FIRST SALE" DEFINED. In this subchapter,
- 26 "first sale":
- 27 (1) as applied to liquor imported into this state by the

- 1 holder of a wholesaler's permit authorizing importation, means the
- 2 first actual sale by the permittee to the holder of any other permit
- 3 authorizing the retail sale of the beverage or to the holder of a
- 4 local distributor's permit; and
- 5 (2) as applied to all other liquor, means the first sale,
- 6 possession, distribution, or use in this state, except that the
- 7 term does not include the first sale by:
- 8 (A) the holder of a winery permit to another holder of
- 9 a winery permit or the holder of a wholesaler's permit; [or]
- 10 (B) the holder of a distiller's and rectifier's permit
- 11 to the holder of a wholesaler's permit; or
- (c) a vintage distilled spirits seller to the holder
- 13 of a package store permit or a local distributor's permit of vintage
- 14 distilled spirits.
- 15 SECTION 7. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
