5	SECTION 1. Chapter 2, Code of Criminal Procedure, is
6	amended by adding Article 2.36 to read as follows:
7	Art. 2.36. DUTY OF LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY TO MAKE CERTAIN
8	RADIO COMMUNICATIONS AVAILABLE TO PUBLIC. (a) In this article:
9	(1) "Law enforcement agency" means an agency of the
10	state or an agency of a political subdivision of the state
11	authorized by law to employ peace officers.
12	(2) "Radio communication" means any audio
13	communication transmitted by a radio system.
14	(3) "Readily accessible to the general public" has the
15	meaning assigned by Section 16.02, Penal Code.
16	(b) Each law enforcement agency shall make radio
17	communications sent by the agency for a law enforcement purpose
18	readily accessible to the general public, except for radio
19	communications sent by designated units in the agency that perform:
20	(1) special operations; or
21	(2) the gathering and analyzing of information for the
22	purpose of generating intelligence.
23	SECTION 2. Notwithstanding Article 2.36, Code of Criminal
24	Procedure, as added by this Act, a law enforcement agency is not

1 required to comply with that article until January 1, 2024.

2 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
