4	SECTION 1. Section 43.955, Parks and Wildlife Code, is
5	amended to read as follows:
6	Sec. 43.955. COST OF ASSESSMENT AND DESTRUCTION OF DEEF
7	[RECOVERY]. (a) The applicable permit holder shall pay all costs
8	associated with:
9	(1) an epidemiological assessment conducted under
10	this subchapter to the animal health commission; and
11	(2) except as provided by Subsection (b), the
12	destruction of deer under this subchapter to the department.
13	(b) Except as provided by Subsection (c), the department
14	shall waive the costs associated with the destruction under this
15	subchapter of breeder deer at a facility covered by a permit issued
16	under Subchapter L where a breeder deer has tested positive for
17	chronic wasting disease in a test performed by a testing laboratory
18	accredited by the Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service of the

  20 <u>(c) The department may not waive costs under Subsection (b)</u>
  21 <u>if the department determines that the permit holder or an agent of</u>
  22 <u>the permit holder, in violation of this chapter or a regulation of</u>
  23 <u>the commission, caused:</u>
- 24 (1) the introduction of chronic wasting disease into

- 1 the facility; or
- 2 (2) a delay in the detection of chronic wasting
- 3 disease at the facility.
- 4 SECTION 2. Section 43.955, Parks and Wildlife Code, as
- 5 amended by this Act, applies only to the payment of costs arising
- 6 from the destruction of deer commenced on or after the effective
- 7 date of this Act.
- 8 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 9 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 10 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 11 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 12 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
