A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT relating to a state employment preference for certain spouses of 2 3 veterans with a disability. Δ BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. Section 657.002, Government Code, is amended to 5 6 read as follows: Sec. 657.002. INDIVIDUALS QUALIFIED VETERAN'S 7 FOR EMPLOYMENT PREFERENCE. The following individuals qualify for a 8 veteran's employment preference: 9 a veteran, including a veteran with a disability; 10 (1) (2) veteran's surviving spouse 11 а who has not 12 remarried; [and] 13 (3) an orphan of a veteran if the veteran was killed 14 while on active duty; and 15 (4) the spouse of a veteran if the spouse is the primary source of income for the household and the veteran has a 16 17 total disability rating based either on having a service-connected disability with a disability rating of at least 70 percent or on 18 individual unemployability. 19 SECTION 2. Section 657.003(b), Government Code, is amended 20 to read as follows: 21 22 (b) A state agency shall provide to an individual entitled to a veteran's employment preference for employment or appointment 23

24 over other applicants for the same position who do not have a

1 greater qualification a veteran's employment preference, in the 2 following order of priority:

3

a veteran with a disability;

4 (2) a veteran;

5 (3) a veteran's surviving spouse who has not 6 remarried; [and]

7 (4) an orphan of a veteran if the veteran was killed8 while on active duty; and

9 (5) the spouse of a veteran with a disability as 10 described by Section 657.002(4) if the spouse is the primary source 11 of income for the veteran's household.

SECTION 3. Section 657.005(b), Government Code, is amended to read as follows:

An applicant who is either a veteran with a disability 14 (b) 15 as described by Section 657.002(4) or the spouse of a veteran with a 16 disability as described by Section 657.002(4) if the spouse is the primary source of income for the veteran's household shall furnish 17 18 the official records to the individual whose duty is to fill the position in a form and manner that demonstrates to the satisfaction 19 20 of the individual that the applicant is entitled to the employment preference. 21

SECTION 4. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to an open position with a state agency for which the state agency begins accepting applications on or after the effective date of this Act. An open position with a state agency for which the state agency begins accepting applications before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the state

1 agency began accepting applications, and the former law is 2 continued in effect for that purpose.

3 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
