- 7 (56) "Supervised Drug Consumption Site" means any facility
- 8 or premises operated or intended to provide an environment for the
- 9 unlawful use of a controlled substance.
- 10 SECTION 2. Subchapter D, Chapter 481, Health and Safety
- 11 Code is amended by adding Section 481.142 to read as follows:
- 12 Sec. 481.142. OFFENSE: OPERATION OF SUPERVISED DRUG
- 13 CONSUMPTION SITES. (a) A person commits an offense if the person:
- 14 (1) knowingly operates a supervised drug consumption
- 15 site as defined by this chapter; or
- 16 (2) either as an owner, lessee, agent, employee,
- 17 occupant, or mortgagee, knowingly and intentionally opens, leases,
- 18 rents, profits from, maintains, or makes available for use, with or
- 19 without compensation, any premises for the purpose of operating a
- 20 supervised drug consumption site as defined by this chapter.
- 21 (b) An offense under Subsection (a) is a felony of the
- 22 second degree.
