

AN ACT

relating to the confidentiality of certain information collected by certain local governments and airport governing boards at a parking facility.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 22, Transportation Code, is amended by adding Section 22.028 to read as follows:

Sec. 22.028. CONFIDENTIALITY OF CERTAIN INFORMATION COLLECTED BY LOCAL GOVERNMENT. Personal identifying information collected by a local government is confidential and not subject to disclosure under Chapter 552, Government Code, if the information collected is in relation to a person's use of an airport parking facility that includes:

(1) the person's name, address, e-mail address, phone number, and zip code;

(2) the person's license plate number, toll tag number, and credit, debit, or other payment card number; or

(3) the dates the person's vehicle was parked at the facility, the date the person's vehicle exited the facility, and the amount the person paid to park in the facility.

SECTION 2. Section 22.091, Transportation Code, is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 22.091. CONFIDENTIALITY OF CERTAIN INFORMATION COLLECTED BY JOINT BOARD. Personal identifying information

1 collected by a joint board for which the constituent agencies are
2 populous home-rule municipalities is confidential and not subject
3 to disclosure under Chapter 552, Government Code, if the
4 information collected is in relation to:

5 (1) a commercial online payment system and includes a
6 person's:

7 (A) [~~(1)~~] name, address, e-mail address, or
8 phone number;

9 (B) [~~(2)~~] account number, password, payment
10 transaction activity, toll or charge record, or credit, debit, or
11 other payment card number; or

12 (C) [~~(3)~~] other personal financial information;
13 or

14 (2) a person's use of an airport parking facility that
15 includes:

16 (A) the person's name, address, e-mail address,
17 phone number, and zip code;

18 (B) the person's license plate number, toll tag
19 number, and credit, debit, or other payment card number; or

20 (C) the dates the person's vehicle was parked at
21 the facility, the date the person's vehicle exited the facility,
22 and the amount the person paid to park in the facility.

23 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only
24 to a request for public information received by a governmental body
25 or an officer for public information on or after the effective date
26 of this Act.

27 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
