- 12 collected is in relation to a person's use of an airport parking
- 13 facility that includes:
- 14 (1) the person's name, address, e-mail address, phone
- 15 number, and zip code;
- 16 (2) the person's license plate number, toll tag
- 17 number, and credit, debit, or other payment card number; or
- 18 (3) the dates the person's vehicle was parked at the
- 19 facility, the date the person's vehicle exited the facility, and
- 20 the amount the person paid to park in the facility.
- 21 SECTION 2. Section 22.091, Transportation Code, is amended
- 22 to read as follows:
- Sec. 22.091. CONFIDENTIALITY OF CERTAIN INFORMATION
- 24 COLLECTED BY JOINT BOARD. Personal identifying information

- 1 collected by a joint board for which the constituent agencies are
- 2 populous home-rule municipalities is confidential and not subject
- 3 to disclosure under Chapter 552, Government Code, if the
- 4 information collected is in relation to:
- 5 (1) a commercial online payment system and includes a
- 6 person's:
- 7 (A) $\left[\frac{1}{1}\right]$ name, address, e-mail address, or
- 8 phone number;
- 9 (B) (B) account number, password, payment
- 10 transaction activity, toll or charge record, or credit, debit, or
- 11 other payment card number; or
- 12 $\underline{\text{(C)}}$ [(3)] other personal financial information;
- 13 or
- 14 (2) a person's use of an airport parking facility that
- 15 includes:
- (A) the person's name, address, e-mail address,
- 17 phone number, and zip code;
- 18 (B) the person's license plate number, toll tag
- 19 number, and credit, debit, or other payment card number; or
- (C) the dates the person's vehicle was parked at
- 21 the facility, the date the person's vehicle exited the facility,
- 22 and the amount the person paid to park in the facility.
- 23 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 24 to a request for public information received by a governmental body
- 25 or an officer for public information on or after the effective date
- 26 of this Act.
- 27 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
