- 2 relating to the payment of gas customer rate relief charges imposed
- 3 for costs related to Winter Storm Uri.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 104.361, Utilities Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 7 <u>(c) The legislature finds and declares that Winter Storm Uri</u>
- 8 constituted a public calamity to this state due to the loss of life,
- 9 injury, property damage, and widespread disruptions of gas supply,
- 10 electricity, and utility services caused by prolonged freezing
- 11 temperatures, heavy snow, and freezing rain statewide.
- SECTION 2. Section 104.373, Utilities Code, is amended by
- 13 adding Subsection (f) to read as follows:
- 14 (f) Notwithstanding any other law, a state agency may
- 15 provide money appropriated for the purpose to the issuing financing
- 16 entity to pay the aggregate customer rate relief charges authorized
- 17 by this subchapter on behalf of customers described by Subsection
- 18 <u>(a).</u>
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
