A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to a supplemental payment for retirees of the Employees
- 3 Retirement System of Texas.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. (a) From funds appropriated for this purpose,
- 6 the Employees Retirement System of Texas shall make a one-time
- 7 supplemental payment of a retirement or death benefit, as provided
- 8 by this section.
- 9 (b) A supplemental payment is payable in January 2024, and,
- 10 to the extent practicable, on a date or dates that coincide with the
- 11 regular annuity payment payable to each eligible annuitant.
- 12 (c) The amount of the supplemental payment is equal to the
- 13 lesser of:
- 14 (1) \$2,500; or
- 15 (2) the gross amount of the regular annuity payment to
- 16 which the eligible annuitant is otherwise entitled for the month of
- 17 December 2023, including, if applicable, the standard combined
- 18 service retirement annuity payable under Section 814.107,
- 19 Government Code.
- 20 (d) The Employees Retirement System of Texas shall make
- 21 applicable tax withholding and other legally required deductions
- 22 before disbursing the supplemental payment. A supplemental payment
- 23 under this section is in addition to and not in lieu of the regular
- 24 monthly annuity payment to which the eligible annuitant is

- 1 otherwise entitled.
- 2 (e) Subject to Subsections (f) and (g) of this section, to
- 3 be eligible for the supplemental payment, a person must be, for the
- 4 month of December 2023, an annuitant eligible to receive:
- 5 (1) a standard retirement annuity payment;
- 6 (2) an optional service retirement annuity payment as
- 7 either a retiree or beneficiary under Section 814.108, Government
- 8 Code;
- 9 (3) a standard or occupational disability retirement
- 10 annuity payment;
- 11 (4) a death benefit annuity payment under Section
- 12 814.305, Government Code; or
- 13 (5) an alternate payee annuity payment under Section
- 14 804.005, Government Code.
- 15 (f) If the annuitant is a retiree or a beneficiary under an
- 16 optional retirement payment plan, to be eligible for the
- 17 supplemental payment, the effective date of the retirement of the
- 18 member of the Employees Retirement System of Texas must have been on
- 19 or before September 1, 2022. The supplemental payment shall be made
- 20 to an alternate payee who is an annuitant under Section 804.005,
- 21 Government Code, only if the annuity payment to the alternate payee
- 22 commenced on or before September 1, 2022. The supplemental payment
- 23 is in addition to the guaranteed number of payments under Section
- 24 814.108, Government Code, and may not be counted as one of the
- 25 guaranteed monthly payments.
- 26 (g) The supplemental payment does not apply to payments
- 27 under:

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- 1 (1) Section 814.103 or 814.205, Government Code,
- 2 relating to retirees or disability retirees from the elected class
- 3 of membership;
- 4 (2) a subtitle other than Subtitle B, Title 8,
- 5 Government Code, except as provided by Subsection (e)(5) of this
- 6 section; or
- 7 (3) Section 814.304, Government Code, relating to
- 8 retiree survivor beneficiaries who receive a survivor annuity as
- 9 the surviving spouse of a member of the elected class.
- 10 (h) Except as provided by this section, the board of
- 11 trustees of the Employees Retirement System of Texas shall
- 12 determine the eligibility for and the amount and timing of a
- 13 supplemental payment and the manner in which the payment is made.
- 14 (i) The supplemental payment is subject solely to the
- 15 availability of appropriated funds. The supplemental payment must
- 16 comply with Section 811.006, Government Code.
- 17 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
