- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter Z, Chapter 51, Education Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 51.987 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 51.987. CERTAIN ACADEMIC BOYCOTTS OF FOREIGN COUNTRIES
- 8 PROHIBITED. (a) In this section, "institution of higher
- 9 education" has the meaning assigned by Section 61.003.
- 10 (b) Subject to Subsection (c), an institution of higher
- 11 education may not implement an academic boycott of a foreign
- 12 country that would prevent a student or faculty member of the
- 13 institution from:
- 14 (1) studying or conducting research in or about the
- 15 country; or
- 16 (2) interacting with the country's scholars or
- 17 representatives.
- 18 (c) An institution of higher education may implement an
- 19 academic boycott described by Subsection (b) of a foreign country
- 20 included by the United States Department of State on a list of state
- 21 <u>sponsors of terrorism.</u>
- 22 (d) The Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board shall
- 23 adopt rules as necessary to implement this section.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
