- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. The heading to Subchapter M, Chapter 113,
- 6 Natural Resources Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 SUBCHAPTER M. REQUIRED NOTICES [CONSUMER SAFETY NOTIFICATION]
- 8 SECTION 2. The heading to Section 113.401, Natural
- 9 Resources Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 10 Sec. 113.401. CONSUMER SAFETY NOTIFICATION [NOTICE
- 11 REQUIRED].
- 12 SECTION 3. Subchapter M, Chapter 113, Natural Resources
- 13 Code, is amended by adding Section 113.402 to read as follows:
- 14 Sec. 113.402. NOTICE FOR CERTAIN STATIONARY LP-GAS
- 15 INSTALLATIONS. (a) For a proposed installation or modification of
- 16 a stationary LP-gas installation with an aggregate water capacity
- 17 of 10,000 gallons or more, the commission shall require the
- 18 applicant to mail notice containing the information required by the
- 19 commission by registered or certified mail, return receipt
- 20 requested, or by any other form of mail that provides proof of
- 21 delivery, to all owners of real property situated within 500 feet of
- 22 the proposed container location.
- 23 (b) The applicant shall maintain a record of the proof of
- 24 delivery for a period of time as determined by the commission.

- 1 (c) The commission may exempt from the requirements of this
 2 section certain installations where LP-gas containers of 10,000
 3 gallons or more aggregate water capacity are used as fuel storage
- 4 supply for asphalt heating.
- 5 SECTION 4. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 6 to an application for the installation or modification of a
- 7 stationary LP-gas installation that is filed with the Railroad
- 8 Commission of Texas on or after the effective date of this Act. An
- 9 application for the installation or modification of a stationary
- 10 LP-gas installation that is filed before the effective date of this
- 11 Act is governed by the law in effect on the date of filing, and that
- 12 law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 13 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 14 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 15 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 16 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 17 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
