A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to requiring public schools to maintain physical copies of
- 3 certain instructional materials.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 31, Education Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 31.107 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 31.107. REQUIRED PHYSICAL COPIES OF INSTRUCTIONAL
- 8 MATERIALS. (a) This section applies only to instructional
- 9 materials provided in a physical medium.
- 10 (b) The board of trustees of each school district and the
- 11 governing body of each open-enrollment charter school shall, for
- 12 <u>each instructional material selected by the district or school for</u>
- 13 <u>a subject in the foundation or enrichment curriculum:</u>
- 14 (1) make available at least one physical copy of the
- 15 instructional material in each classroom in which the instructional
- 16 material is used;
- 17 (2) provide to each teacher at a district or school who
- 18 uses the instructional material in teaching a course a physical
- 19 copy of the teacher version of the instructional material, if
- 20 <u>available</u>; and
- 21 (3) maintain in the school library at each district or
- 22 school campus at which the instructional material is used a number
- 23 of physical copies of the instructional material at least equal to
- 24 five percent of the total number of students in the grade level in

- 1 which the instructional material is used.
- 2 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2023-2024
- 3 school year.
- 4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
