- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 31, Education Code, is 6 amended by adding Section 31.107 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 31.107. REQUIRED PHYSICAL COPIES OF INSTRUCTIONAL
- 8 MATERIALS. The board of trustees of each school district and the
- 9 governing body of each open-enrollment charter school shall, for
- 10 each instructional material selected by the district or school for
- 11 a subject in the foundation or enrichment curriculum:
- 12 (1) make available at least one physical copy of the
- 13 <u>instructional material in each classroom in which the instructional</u>
- 14 material is used;

- 15 (2) provide to each teacher at a district or school who
- 16 uses the instructional material in teaching a course a physical
- 17 copy of the teacher version of the instructional material, if
- 18 available; and
- 19 (3) maintain in the school library at each district or
- 20 school campus at which the instructional material is used a number
- 21 of physical copies of the instructional material at least equal to
- 22 five percent of the total number of students in the grade level in
- 23 which the instructional material is used.
- SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2023-2024

- 2 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
