1-21 relating to the authority of a member of the State Board of
 1-22 Education to request an attorney general opinion.

1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Section 402.042(b), Government Code, is amended
 1-25 to read as follows:

1-26 (b) An opinion may be requested by:

- 1-27 (1) the governor;
- 1-28 (2) the head of a department of state government;
- 1-29 (3) a head or board of a penal institution;
- 1-30 (4) a head or board of an eleemosynary institution;
- 1-31 (5) the head of a state board;
- 1-32 (6) a regent or trustee of a state educational
 1-33 institution;
- 1-34 (7) a committee of a house of the legislature;
- 1-35 (8) a county auditor authorized by law; [~~or~~]
- 1-36 (9) the chairman of the governing board of a river
 1-37 authority; or
- 1-38 (10) a member of the State Board of Education.

1-39 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-40 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-41 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-42 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-43 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
