1-19 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-20 AN ACT

1-21 relating to discounts provided by package store and wine only
 1-22 package store permit holders on the purchase of alcoholic
 1-23 beverages.

1-24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-25 SECTION 1. Section 102.07, Alcoholic Beverage Code, is
 1-26 amended by amending Subsections (c) and (d) and adding Subsection
 1-27 (d-1) to read as follows:

1-28 (c) Except as provided by Subsection (d-1), no [No] person
 1-29 who owns or has an interest in the business of a package store or
 1-30 wine only package store, nor the agent, servant, or employee of the
 1-31 person, may allow an excessive discount on liquor.

1-32 (d) A permittee covered under Subsection (a) may offer
 1-33 prizes, premiums, or gifts to a consumer. Except as provided by
 1-34 Subsection (d-1), the [The] use of rebates or coupons redeemable by
 1-35 the public for the purchase of alcoholic beverages is prohibited.
 1-36 The holder of a winery permit may furnish to a retailer without cost
 1-37 recipes, recipe books, book matches, cocktail napkins, or other
 1-38 advertising items showing the name of the winery furnishing the
 1-39 items or the brand name of the product advertised if the individual
 1-40 cost of the items does not exceed \$1.

1-41 (d-1) The holder of a package store permit or wine only
 1-42 package store permit may:

1-43 (1) offer coupons redeemable by the public for the
 1-44 purchase of alcoholic beverages; and

1-45 (2) provide a discount of any amount on the purchase of
 1-46 liquor using a coupon redeemable by the public.

1-47 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
