## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

## AN ACT

2 relating to the authorization of distributors to provide malt 3 beverage products to retailers for authorized sampling purposes.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 102.02, Alcoholic Beverage Code, is 6 amended to read as follows:

Sec. 102.02. PROVIDING SAMPLES. Notwithstanding any other 7 provision of this code, the holder of a wholesaler's 8 or distributor's permit or the holder's agent, representative, or 9 10 employee may furnish or give a sample of liquor or malt beverages to a holder of a permit authorizing the sale of that category of 11 12 alcoholic beverage at retail if the retail permittee has not previously purchased that brand from that wholesaler or distributor 13 permittee. The wholesaler or distributor may give the retail 14 permittee not more than 750 milliliters of any brand of distilled 15 spirits, not more than three liters of any brand of wine in that 16 package, and not more than one six pack 72 ounces of any other 17 alcoholic beverage so packaged. The retail permittee or the 18 permittee's agent, servant, or employee may sample the product on 19 the licensed premises only if the wholesaler or distributor the 20 wholesaler's or distributor's agent, servant, or employee 21 is present. 22
