4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subtitle B, Title 4, Labor Code, is amended by
6	adding Chapter 319 to read as follows:
7	CHAPTER 319. POSTING OF INFORMATION ABOUT BENEFITS AND SERVICES FOR
8	<u>VETERANS</u>
9	Sec. 319.001. VETERANS BENEFITS AND SERVICES POSTER. (a)
10	In this section, "employer" means a person who employs at least 50
11	employees.
12	(b) The commission shall, in consultation with the Texas
13	Veterans Commission, create and distribute to each employer in this
14	state a veterans benefits and services poster containing
15	information relating to:
16	(1) how an employee may:
17	(A) apply for unemployment compensation benefits
18	under Subtitle A and unemployment compensation benefits that may be
19	offered under a program administered by an agency of the federal
20	government;
21	(B) contact the Texas Veterans Commission,
22	including how an employee may access the Internet website
23	maintained by the Texas Veterans Commission and the veterans crisis
24	hotline established by the United States Department of Veterans

- 1 Affairs under 38 U.S.C. Section 1720F;
- 2 (C) exercise any tax benefits or preferences
- 3 offered to veterans under the Tax Code or Internal Revenue Code of
- 4 1986; and
- 5 (D) obtain a driver's license or personal
- 6 identification card issued by the Department of Public Safety; and
- 7 (2) services that may be available to veterans in this
- 8 state, including:
- 9 (A) education, workforce placement, and training
- 10 programs;
- 11 (B) legal assistance; and
- 12 (C) substance abuse and mental health treatment.
- 13 (c) Each employer shall display the veterans benefits and
- 14 services poster distributed by the commission under this section in
- 15 <u>a conspicuous place in the employer's place of business that is</u>
- 16 accessible to all employees.
- SECTION 2. Not later than December 1, 2023, the Texas
- 18 Workforce Commission shall, in consultation with the Texas Veterans
- 19 Commission, create and distribute the veterans benefits and
- 20 services poster as required by Section 319.001, Labor Code, as
- 21 added by this Act.
- 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
