| 9  | In this section:   |
| 10 | (1) "Consumer" has the meaning assigned by Section                 |
| 11 | <u>531.051.</u>  |
| 12 | (2) "Personal attendant" means an individual who is                |
| 13 | authorized to provide attendant care services to a consumer who is |
| 14 | eligible to receive those services under:                          |
| 15 | (A) Medicaid, including a waiver or other program                  |
| 16 | established under:   |
| 17 | (i) Section 1115 of the Social Security Act                        |
| 18 | (42 U.S.C. Section 1315);  |
| 19 | (ii) Section 1915(b), (c), or (k) of the                           |
| 20 | Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. Section 1396n(b), (c), or (k)); or  |
| 21 | (iii) Section 1929 of the Social Security                          |
| 22 | Act (42 U.S.C. Section 1396t); or                                  |
| 23 | (B) a social services block grant under Title XX                   |
| 24 | of the Social Security Act.  |

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| 1  | (b) To the extent permitted by federal law, a personal               |
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| 2  | attendant who provides services to a consumer may be a family member |
| 3  | of the consumer, including the consumer's parent or spouse.          |
| 4  | SECTION 2. Subchapter B, Chapter 32, Human Resources Code,           |
| 5  | is amended by adding Section 32.0611 to read as follows:             |
| 6  | Sec. 32.0611. COMMUNITY ATTENDANT SERVICES PROGRAM:                  |
| 7  | MINIMUM WAGE FOR COMMUNITY ATTENDANTS. Notwithstanding Section       |
| 8  | 62.051 or 62.151, Labor Code, or any other law, a community          |
| 9  | attendant providing services to a recipient under the community      |
| 10 | attendant services program must be paid not less than the greater    |
| 11 | <u>of:</u>   |
| 12 | (1) \$15 an hour; or   |
| 13 | (2) the federal minimum wage under Section 6, Fair                   |
| 14 | Labor Standards Act of 1938 (29 U.S.C. Section 206).                 |
| 15 | SECTION 3. If before implementing any provision of this Act          |
| 16 | a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a      |
| 17 | federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision,    |
| 18 | the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or     |
| 19 | authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the    |
| 20 | waiver or authorization is granted.                                  |
| 21 | SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.                  |

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
