- 4 Conservation District; authorizing an increase in the rate of the

- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 7 SECTION 1. Section 8802.1045(g), Special District Local
- 8 Laws Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 9 (g) This subsection applies only to a well located in the
- 10 shared territory described by Section 8802.0035. Notwithstanding
- 11 Subsection (b), before September 1, 2023, the district may not
- 12 charge an annual production fee of more than 17 cents per thousand
- 13 gallons of water authorized to be produced under a permit from a
- 14 well under this subsection, if the water is permitted for any use
- 15 other than agricultural use. The district may increase the annual
- 16 production fee under this subsection by not more than 10 cents per
- 17 thousand gallons per year beginning on September 1, 2023, for water
- 18 permitted for nonagricultural purposes, until the annual
- 19 production fee is equal to the maximum amount set forth in
- 20 Subsection (b).
- 21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
