## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to an exemption from the requirement to obtain a permit from a groundwater conservation district for certain temporary 3 water wells. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5 SECTION 1. Sections 36.117(b) and (d), Water Code, are 6 amended to read as follows: 7 (b) Except as provided by this section, a district shall 8 provide an exemption from the district requirement to obtain a 9 permit for: 10 11 (1)drilling or operating a well used solely for 12 domestic use or for providing water for livestock or poultry if the well is: 13 14 (A) located or to be located on a tract of land larger than 10 acres; and 15 drilled, completed, or equipped so that it is 16 (B) incapable of producing more than 25,000 gallons of groundwater a 17 18 day; drilling a water well used solely to supply water 19 (2) 20 for a rig that is actively engaged in drilling or exploration 21 operations for an oil or gas well permitted by the Railroad Commission of Texas provided that the person holding the permit is 22 23 responsible for drilling and operating the water well and the water well is located on the same lease or field associated with the 24

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1 drilling rig; [<del>or</del>]

(3) drilling a water well authorized under a permit
issued by the Railroad Commission of Texas under Chapter 134,
Natural Resources Code, or for production from the well to the
extent the withdrawals are required for mining activities
regardless of any subsequent use of the water; or

7 (4) drilling a water well for temporary use to supply
8 water for a rig that is actively engaged in drilling a groundwater
9 production well permitted by the district.

10 (d) A district may cancel a previously granted exemption and 11 may require an operating permit for or restrict production from a 12 well and assess any appropriate fees if:

(1) the groundwater withdrawals that were exempted under Subsection (b)(1) are no longer used solely for domestic use or to provide water for livestock or poultry;

16 (2) the groundwater withdrawals that were exempted 17 under Subsection (b)(2) are no longer used solely to supply water 18 for a rig that is actively engaged in drilling or exploration 19 operations for an oil or gas well permitted by the Railroad 20 Commission of Texas; [<del>or</del>]

(3) the groundwater withdrawals that were exempted under Subsection (b)(3) are no longer necessary for mining activities or are greater than the amount necessary for mining activities specified in the permit issued by the Railroad Commission of Texas under Chapter 134, Natural Resources Code; or (4) the groundwater withdrawals that were exempted under Subsection (b)(4) are no longer used solely to supply water

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- 1 for a rig that is actively engaged in drilling a groundwater 2 production well permitted by the district.
- 3 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
