(a) 9 The commission shall adopt rules establishing identification 10 requirements for department contractors and subcontractors while 11 working at the site of a construction, maintenance, or improvement 12 project of the department. 13 14 (b) The rules adopted under Subsection (a) must require: (1) an employee of the contractor or subcontractor 15 16 while working at the site of the project to wear an identification badge, in the form and manner prescribed by the commission, that 17 clearly identifies the employee as a department contractor or 18 19 subcontractor; and (2) each vehicle of the contractor or subcontractor 20 21 while the vehicle is at the site of the project to display on each side of the vehicle, in the form and manner prescribed by the 22 23 commission, insignia or other markings identifying the vehicle as a vehicle of a department contractor or subcontractor. 24
