S.B. No. 1775

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to on-site identification requirements for certain
3 contractors and subcontractors of the Texas Department of
4 Transportation.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Subchapter H, Chapter 201, Transportation Code,
7 is amended by adding Section 201.625 to read as follows:

8 Sec. 201.625. ON-SITE IDENTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS FOR
9 CERTAIN DEPARTMENT CONTRACTORS AND SUBCONTRACTORS. (a) The
10 commission shall adopt rules establishing identification
11 requirements for department contractors and subcontractors while
12 working at the site of a construction, maintenance, or improvement
13 project of the department.

14 (b) The rules adopted under Subsection (a) must require:

15 (1) an employee of the contractor or subcontractor
16 while working at the site of the project to wear an identification
17 badge, in the form and manner prescribed by the commission, that
18 clearly identifies the employee as a department contractor or
19 subcontractor; and

20 (2) each vehicle of the contractor or subcontractor
21 while the vehicle is at the site of the project to display on each
22 side of the vehicle, in the form and manner prescribed by the
23 commission, insignia or other markings identifying the vehicle as a
24 vehicle of a department contractor or subcontractor.

1 SECTION 2. Not later than December 1, 2023, the Texas
2 Transportation Commission shall adopt the rules required by Section
3 201.625, Transportation Code, as added by this Act.

4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
