1-19 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-20 AN ACT

1-21 relating to administrative procedures in the architectural
 1-22 barriers program at the Texas Department of Licensing and
 1-23 Regulation.

1-24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-25 SECTION 1. Section 469.058(a), Government Code, is amended
 1-26 to read as follows:

1-27 (a) The commission or executive director may impose an
 1-28 administrative penalty under Subchapter F, Chapter 51, Occupations
 1-29 Code, on a building owner for a violation of this chapter or a rule
 1-30 adopted under this chapter.

1-31 SECTION 2. Section 469.106(a), Government Code, is amended
 1-32 to read as follows:

1-33 (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter,
 1-34 the commission shall require complete compliance with the standards
 1-35 and specifications adopted by the commission under this chapter
 1-36 that apply specifically to a building or facility occupied by a
 1-37 state agency involved in extending direct services to persons with
 1-38 mobility impairments. Those standards and specifications also
 1-39 apply to a building or facility occupied by the Health and Human
 1-40 Services Commission [~~Texas Rehabilitation Commission~~].

1-41 SECTION 3. Section 469.058(c) and Section 469.059(c),
 1-42 Government Code, are repealed.

1-43 SECTION 4. The changes in law made by this Act do not affect
 1-44 the validity of a disciplinary action or other proceeding that was
 1-45 initiated before September 1, 2023, and that is pending on
 1-46 September 1, 2023. A disciplinary action that is pending on
 1-47 September 1, 2023, is governed by the law in effect immediately
 1-48 before September 1, 2023, and the former law is continued in effect
 1-49 for that purpose.

1-50 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
