BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 122.0331, Election Code, is amended by adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:

(e) A manufacturer of voting systems used in an election may not enter into a contract, or extend or renew a contract, for software development services with:

(1) a company or other entity headquartered in China,

Cuba, Iran, North Korea, or Russia; or
(2) an individual who is based in China, Cuba, Iran,
