5	SECTION 1. The heading to Subchapter M, Chapter 113 ,
6	Natural Resources Code, is amended to read as follows:
7	SUBCHAPTER M. <u>REQUIRED NOTICES</u> [CONSUMER SAFETY
8	NOTIFICATION]
9	SECTION 2. The heading to Section 113.401, Natural
10	Resources Code, is amended to read as follows:
11	Sec. 113.401. <u>CONSUMER SAFETY NOTIFICATION</u> [NOTICE
12	REQUIRED].
13	SECTION 3. Subchapter M, Chapter 113, Natural Resources
14	Code, is amended by adding Section 113.402 to read as follows:
15	Sec. 113.402. NOTICE FOR CERTAIN STATIONARY LP-GAS
16	INSTALLATIONS. (a) For a proposed installation or modification of
17	a stationary LP-gas installation with an aggregate water capacity
18	of 10,000 gallons or more, the commission shall require the
19	applicant to mail notice containing the information required by the
20	commission by registered or certified mail, return receipt
21	requested, or by any other form of mail that provides proof of
22	delivery, to all owners of real property situated within one mile of
23	the proposed container location.
24	(b) The applicant shall maintain a record of the proof of

1 delivery for a period of time as determined by the commission.

2 SECTION 4. The change in law made by this Act applies only to an application for the installation or modification of a 3 stationary LP-gas installation that is filed with the Railroad 4 Commission of Texas on or after the effective date of this Act. An 5 application for the installation or modification of a stationary 6 7 LP-gas installation that is filed before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date of filing, and that 8 9 law is continued in effect for that purpose.

10 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 11 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 12 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 13 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 14 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
