- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 71, Government Code, is
- amended by adding Section 71.040 to read as follows: 7
- Sec. 71.040. CENTERS OF EXCELLENCE. (a) The council by 8
- rule shall develop a centers of excellence program to identify, 9
- 10 support, and recognize justices and judges who excel in serving
- their communities and in representing the judiciary. In awarding a 11
- center of excellence recognition to a justice or judge, the council 12
- must consider: 13
- 14 (1) a justice's or judge's governance, access,
- 15 fairness, case flow management, and court operations; and
- (2) the compliance of the justice's or judge's court 16
- 17 with statutory or procedural requirements for judicial reporting,
