## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to compensation and leave for certain employees of the
- 3 office of inspector general of the Texas Juvenile Justice
- 4 Department.

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- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 659.301(5), Government Code, is amended 7 to read as follows:
- 8 (5) "State employee" means an individual who:
- 9 (A) is a commissioned law enforcement officer of
- 10 the Department of Public Safety, the Texas Facilities Commission,
- 11 the Texas Alcoholic Beverage Commission, the Texas Department of
- 12 Criminal Justice, the attorney general, [or] the insurance fraud
- 13 unit of the Texas Department of Insurance, or the office of
- 14 inspector general of the Texas Juvenile Justice Department;
- 15 (B) is a commissioned security officer of the
- 16 comptroller;
- 17 (C) is a law enforcement officer commissioned by
- 18 the Parks and Wildlife Commission;
- 19 (D) is a commissioned peace officer of an
- 20 institution of higher education;
- 21 (E) is an employee or official of the Board of
- 22 Pardons and Paroles or the parole division of the Texas Department
- 23 of Criminal Justice if the employee or official has routine direct
- 24 contact with inmates of any penal or correctional institution or

- 1 with administratively released prisoners subject to the board's
- 2 jurisdiction;
- 3 (F) has been certified to the Employees
- 4 Retirement System of Texas under Section 815.505 as having begun
- 5 employment as a law enforcement officer or custodial officer,
- 6 unless the individual has been certified to the system as having
- 7 ceased employment as a law enforcement officer or custodial
- 8 officer;
- 9 (G) before May 29, 1987, received hazardous duty
- 10 pay based on the terms of any state law if the individual holds a
- 11 position designated under that law as eligible for the pay; or
- 12 (H) is a security officer employed by the Texas
- 13 Military Department.
- SECTION 2. Section 661.918(a), Government Code, is amended
- 15 to read as follows:
- 16 (a) This section applies to a peace officer under Article
- 17 2.12, Code of Criminal Procedure, who is commissioned as a law
- 18 enforcement officer or agent, including a ranger, by:
- 19 (1) the Public Safety Commission and the director of
- 20 the Department of Public Safety;
- 21 (2) the Parks and Wildlife Commission;
- 22 (3) the Texas Alcoholic Beverage Commission;
- 23 (4) the attorney general; [<del>or</del>]
- 24 (5) the insurance fraud unit of the Texas Department
- 25 of Insurance; or
- 26 (6) the office of inspector general of the Texas
- 27 Juvenile Justice Department.

- 1 SECTION 3. Section 242.102, Human Resources Code, is
- 2 amended by adding Subsection (j) to read as follows:
- 3 (j) The department shall ensure that a peace officer
- 4 commissioned under Subsection (d) is compensated according to
- 5 Schedule C of the position classification salary schedule
- 6 prescribed by the General Appropriations Act.
- 7 SECTION 4. (a) The classification officer in the office of
- 8 the state auditor shall classify the position of commissioned peace
- 9 officer employed by the office of inspector general of the Texas
- 10 Juvenile Justice Department as a Schedule C position under the
- 11 Texas Position Classification Plan.
- 12 (b) The change made by the classification officer as
- 13 required by this section applies beginning with the state fiscal
- 14 biennium beginning September 1, 2023.
- 15 (c) This section expires September 1, 2025.
- SECTION 5. Section 661.918(a), Government Code, as amended
- 17 by this Act, applies only to an injury that occurs on or after the
- 18 effective date of this Act.
- 19 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
