No. 1977 1 (6) is or ever has been in: 2 (A) the conservatorship of the Department of 3 Family and Protective Services following an adversary hearing held as provided by Section 262.201, Family Code; or 4 5 (B) foster care in another state or territory, if 6 the child resides in this state; [or] 7 (7) is the child of a person eligible for the Star of 8 Texas Award as: 9 (A) a peace officer under Section 3106.002, 10 Government Code; 11 (B) firefighter under Section 3106.003, а 12 Government Code; or an emergency medical first responder under 13 (C) 14 Section 3106.004, Government Code; or 15 (8) is a child eligible for special education services 16 under Subchapter A and the child's admission, review, and dismissal 17 committee determines the prekindergarten class to be the appropriate placement for the child under 18 the child's 19 individualized education program. SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2023-2024 20 school year. 21 SECTION 3. 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 25 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 26 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
