| 5 | SECTION 1. Chapter 111, Occupations Code, is amended by |
| 6 | adding Section 111.010 to read as follows: |
| 7 | Sec. 111.010. RESTRICTION ON SALE OR SHARING OF PATIENT |
| 8 | INFORMATION. (a) In this section: |
| 9 | (1) "Patient information" means any information |
| 10 | relating to: |
| 11 | (A) the past, present, or future physical or |
| 12 | mental health condition of an individual; |
| 13 | (B) the provision of health care to an |
| 14 | individual; or |
| 15 | (C) the past, present, or future payment for the |
| 16 | provision of health care to an individual. |
| 17 | (2) "Social media platform" has the meaning assigned |
| 18 | by Section 120.001, Business & Commerce Code. |
| 19 | (b) A physician, health professional, or dentist may not |
| 20 | provide a telemedicine medical service, telehealth service, or |
| 21 | teledentistry dental service, as applicable, through an entity that |
| 22 | provides telecommunications or information technology to enable |
| 23 | the service if the entity engages in the sale of the patient |
| 24 | information of a patient of the physician, health professional, or |

- 1 dentist to or otherwise shares the patient information with a
- 2 social media platform.
- 3 (c) A physician, health professional, or dentist who
- 4 knowingly violates this section is subject to disciplinary action
- 5 by the applicable licensing entity, unless the physician, health
- 6 professional, or dentist had received written assurances from the
- 7 entity providing telecommunications or information technology that
- 8 the entity appropriately safeguards patient information of the
- 9 physician's, health professional's, or dentist's patients.
- 10 (d) An entity that provides telecommunications or
- 11 information technology to enable a telemedicine medical service,
- 12 telehealth service, or teledentistry service may not sell or
- 13 otherwise share patient information with a social media platform.
- 14 A violation of this subsection may be enforced in the same manner as
- 15 <u>a violation of Chapter 181, Health and Safety Code, is enforced</u>
- 16 under Subchapter E of that chapter.
- 17 (e) A licensing entity may adopt rules necessary to
- 18 implement this section.
- 19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
