S.B. No. 2076

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT  
2 relating to access by members of the legislature to training  
3 materials used by state agencies.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 656, Government Code, is  
6 amended by adding Section 656.056 to read as follows:

7 Sec. 656.056. LEGISLATIVE ACCESS TO TRAINING MATERIALS. A  
8 state agency shall make available to members of the legislature the  
9 training materials it provides to agency employees, including  
10 presentation slides, memoranda, videos, and other materials. With  
11 each set of training materials, the agency shall include:

12 (1) a brief description of the purpose of the  
13 training;

14 (2) to whom the training is provided;

15 (3) how often the training is provided;

16 (4) whether the training is mandatory or voluntary;

17 and

18 (5) whether the training materials were created by the  
19 state agency and, if not, the source of the materials.

20 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
