| 7 | Sec. 4901.01051. MAP OF AREAS RECEIVING SUPPORT FOR |
| 8 | BROADBAND AND CERTAIN TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES; REPORT. (a) The |
| 9 | broadband development office and the Public Utility Commission of |
| 10 | Texas shall jointly create, update annually, and publish on the |
| 11 | comptroller's and commission's Internet websites a map that shows |
| 12 | areas in this state that are: |
| 13 | (1) classified as eligible under Section 490I.0105; |
| 14 | (2) served by an eligible provider under Section |
| 15 | 56.023, Utilities Code, that receives support for that purpose |
| 16 | under a plan of the state universal service fund established under |
| 17 | Section 56.021, Utilities Code; and |
| 18 | (3) described by both Subdivisions (1) and (2). |
| 19 | (b) Not later than December 1 of each year, the broadband |
| 20 | development office and the Public Utility Commission of Texas shall |
| 21 | submit a joint report to the governor, the lieutenant governor, the |
| 22 | speaker of the house of representatives, and the legislature that |
| 23 | shows the areas described by Subsection (a)(3) and recommendations |

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for withdrawing in those areas support from a plan of the state

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- 1 universal service fund established under Section 56.021, Utilities
- 2 Code, through a reasonable transition period.
- 3 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
