1-21 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-22 AN ACT

1-23 relating to the identification of locations receiving broadband and
 1-24 certain telecommunications services.

1-25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-26 SECTION 1. Chapter 490I, Government Code, is amended by
 1-27 adding Section 490I.01051 to read as follows:

1-28 Sec. 490I.01051. MAP OF LOCATIONS RECEIVING BROADBAND AND
 1-29 CERTAIN TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES; REPORT. (a) The Public
 1-30 Utility Commission of Texas shall create, update annually, and
 1-31 publish on the commission's Internet website a map that shows
 1-32 locations in this state that are:

1-33 (1) receiving reliable broadband service at speeds of
 1-34 not less than 100 megabits per second for a download and not less
 1-35 than 20 megabits per second for an upload;

1-36 (2) served by an eligible telecommunications provider
 1-37 under Section 56.023, Utilities Code, that receives support for
 1-38 that purpose under a plan of the state universal service fund
 1-39 established under Section 56.021, Utilities Code; and

1-40 (3) described by both Subdivisions (1) and (2).

1-41 (b) The comptroller shall assist the Public Utility
 1-42 Commission of Texas in creating and updating the map described by
 1-43 Subsection (a).

1-44 (c) Not later than December 1 of each year, the Public
 1-45 Utility Commission of Texas shall submit a report to the governor,
 1-46 the lieutenant governor, the speaker of the house of
 1-47 representatives, and the legislature that shows the locations
 1-48 described by Subsection (a)(3).

1-49 SECTION 2. The Public Utility Commission of Texas must
 1-50 submit the first report required under Section 490I.01051,
 1-51 Government Code, as added by this Act, not later than December 1,
 1-52 2024.

1-53 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
