1-25 relating to the participation of the medical school at The
 1-26 University of Texas Health Science Center at Tyler in the Joint
 1-27 Admission Medical Program.

1-28 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-29 SECTION 1. Section 51.821(4), Education Code, is amended to
 1-30 read as follows:

1-31 (4) "Participating medical school" means each of the
 1-32 following entities:

1-33 (A) the medical school at The University of Texas
 1-34 Health Science Center at Houston;

1-35 (B) the medical school at The University of Texas
 1-36 Southwestern Medical Center;

1-37 (C) the medical school at The University of Texas
 1-38 Health Science Center at San Antonio;

1-39 (D) the medical school at The University of Texas
 1-40 Medical Branch at Galveston;

1-41 (E) the medical school at the Texas Tech
 1-42 University Health Sciences Center at Lubbock;

1-43 (F) the medical school at the Texas Tech
 1-44 University Health Sciences Center at El Paso;

1-45 (G) the Baylor College of Medicine;

1-46 (H) the college of osteopathic medicine at the
 1-47 University of North Texas Health Science Center at Fort Worth;

1-48 (I) the medical school at The Texas A&M
 1-49 University System Health Science Center;

1-50 (J) the medical school at The University of Texas
 1-51 at Austin;

1-52 (K) the medical school at The University of Texas
 1-53 Rio Grande Valley;

1-54 (L) the medical school at the University of
 1-55 Houston; ~~and~~

1-56 (M) the college of osteopathic medicine at Sam
 1-57 Houston State University; and

1-58 (N) the medical school at The University of Texas
 1-59 Health Science Center at Tyler.

1-60 SECTION 2. (a) As soon as practicable after the effective

2-1 date of this Act, the medical school at The University of Texas
2-2 Health Science Center at Tyler shall:
2-3 (1) enter into the agreement with the Joint Admission
2-4 Medical Program Council required by Section 51.829, Education Code;
2-5 and
2-6 (2) select an appropriate faculty member to represent
2-7 the medical school on the council.
2-8 (b) The medical school at The University of Texas Health
2-9 Science Center at Tyler shall provide internships and mentoring
2-10 under the Joint Admission Medical Program as appropriate beginning
2-11 not later than the 2025-2026 academic year, but is not required
2-12 before the 2026-2027 academic year to admit participating students
2-13 to the school under the program.
2-14 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
2-15 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
2-16 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
2-17 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
2-18 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
