## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

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- 2 relating to the suspension of the authority of a county election 3 officer.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 31, Election Code, is 6 amended by adding Section 31.131 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 31.131. SUSPENSION OF COUNTY ELECTION OFFICER BY
- 8 SECRETARY OF STATE. (a) In this section, "county election officer"
- 9 means the county elections administrator in counties having that
- 10 position, the county tax assessor-collector in counties in which
- 11 the county clerk's position duties and functions have been
- 12 transferred to the tax assessor-collector, and the county clerk in
- 13 other counties.

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- 14 (b) The secretary of state may enter a written order to
- 15 suspend the authority of a county election officer to carry out the
- 16 officer's powers and duties under this code at any time if the
- 17 secretary of state has good cause to determine that the county
- 18 election officer has not substantially cooperated with an audit
- 19 conducted by the secretary of state under Section 127.351.
- 20 <u>(c) The secretary of state shall establish by rule the</u>
- 21 standards for substantial cooperation with an audit conducted under
- 22 Section 127.351.
- 23 (d) After the secretary of state determines that a county
- 24 election officer did not substantially cooperate with an audit, the

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- 1 county may not reduce the county election officer's budget from the
- 2 previous year until the period of conservatorship under Subsection
- 3 (e) has ended.
- 4 (e) The authority of a county election officer suspended as
- 5 provided by Subsection (b) must be fulfilled by a conservator
- 6 appointed by the secretary of state. A conservator appointed by the
- 7 secretary of state under this subsection serves until a lack of
- 8 substantial cooperation under secretary rule does not occur in a
- 9 general election held in the county within two federal election
- 10 cycles.
- 11 (f) The suspension of the authority of a county election
- 12 officer under this section remains in effect as provided by
- 13 Subsection (e) regardless of whether the individual who holds the
- 14 office or position described by Subsection (a) is the same
- 15 individual who held the office or position on the date the secretary
- 16 of state determined that a lack of substantial cooperation
- 17 occurred.
- 18 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
