## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to emergency planning for the transportation of certain
3	end stage renal disease facility patients during a declared
4	disaster.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Section 773.050, Health and Safety Code, is
7	amended by adding Subsection (j) to read as follows:
8	(j) Consistent with rules adopted under Section 773.112,
9	the executive commissioner by rule shall require that each
10	applicable emergency medical services provider have a plan for
11	providing a dialysis patient who places an emergency 9-1-1
12	telephone call during a declared disaster an alternative mode of
13	transportation directly to and from an outpatient end stage renal
14	disease facility if the patient's normal and alternative modes of
15	transportation cannot be used during the disaster. An emergency
16	medical services provider's plan under this subsection may
17	prioritize providing transportation for a patient suffering from an
18	acute emergency condition over transportation for a dialysis
19	patient. For purposes of this subsection:
20	(1) "Disaster" has the meaning assigned by Section
21	418.004, Government Code. The term includes a disaster declared
22	by:
23	(A) the president of the United States under the
24	Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act (42

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1	U.S.C. Section 5121 et seq.); and
2	(B) the governor under Section 418.014,
3	Government Code.
4	(2) "End stage renal disease facility" has the meaning
5	assigned by Section 251.001.
6	SECTION 2. Section 773.112(d), Health and Safety Code, is
7	repealed.
8	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
