## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2	relating to requiring the attorney general to establish a process
3	to identify and report certain foreign-related transactions in this
4	state to the Committee on Foreign Investment in the United States.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 402, Government Code, is
7	amended by adding Section 402.040 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 402.040. REPORTING NON-NOTIFIED FOREIGN TRANSACTIONS.
9	(a) In this section, "non-notified transactions" means foreign
10	investments in the United States that are not voluntarily submitted
11	to the Committee on Foreign Investment in the United States for
12	review under 50 U.S.C. Section 4565.
13	(b) The office of the attorney general shall establish a
14	process by which local officials, state officials, or other persons
15	may submit to the office information or concerns regarding
16	non-notified transactions in this state. The office of the attorney
17	general may adopt any necessary rules to implement this subsection.
18	(c) The attorney general may submit a memorandum or report
19	concerning non-notified transactions the office of the attorney
20	general has identified in this state to the Committee on Foreign
21	Investment in the United States.
22	(e) The office of the attorney general shall:
23	(1) retain a copy of any documents submitted to the
24	committee described by Subsection (c) that are included with a

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- 1 memorandum or report submitted under that subsection; and
- 2 (2) notify the legislature and the governor as soon as
- 3 practicable after submitting a memorandum, report, or other
- 4 <u>information under Subsection (c) or (d).</u>
- 5 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
