A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to the establishment of a task force to analyze the
- 3 provision of financial assistance from the flood infrastructure
- 4 fund for the improvement of artificial drainage systems in certain
- 5 coastal and border regions.
- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 7 SECTION 1. DEFINITIONS. In this section:
- 8 (1) "Board" means the Texas Water Development Board.
- 9 (2) "Fund" means the flood infrastructure fund 10 established under Section 15.533, Water Code.
- 11 (3) "Task force" means the artificial drainage systems
- 12 task force.
- 13 SECTION 2. TASK FORCE. (a) The artificial drainage systems
- 14 task force is established to identify inadequacies in and suggest
- 15 improvements for the provision of financial assistance for
- 16 artificial drainage systems to communities and drainage districts
- 17 in coastal and border regions of this state that lack topographic
- 18 relief, slope, and naturally defined floodways.
- 19 (b) The task force is composed of:
- 20 (1) an equal number of members of the house of
- 21 representatives and members of the senate with the members of the
- 22 house of representatives appointed by the speaker of the house and
- 23 the members of the senate appointed by the lieutenant governor;
- 24 (2) individuals to represent the interests of drainage

- 1 districts, municipalities, and counties located in coastal and
- 2 border regions, appointed in equal numbers by the speaker of the
- 3 house of representatives and the lieutenant governor; and
- 4 (3) representatives of the board, appointed by the
- 5 executive administrator of the board.
- 6 (c) The task force shall analyze the requirements
- 7 associated with the provision of financial assistance from the fund
- 8 and identify possible changes to those requirements that would
- 9 facilitate the improvement of artificial drainage systems in
- 10 coastal and border regions, including:
- 11 (1) alterations to the scoring criteria used to
- 12 determine the eligibility for and the amount of loans and grants
- 13 provided from the fund, such as:
- 14 (A) the inclusion of scoring criteria that
- 15 prioritize improvements to an artificial drainage system; or
- 16 (B) scoring criteria to be used for communities
- 17 with artificial drainage systems that are based on a social
- 18 vulnerability index instead of income levels; and
- 19 (2) the feasibility of:
- 20 (A) providing no-interest loans for improvements
- 21 to an artificial drainage system;
- 22 (B) introducing a loan forgiveness program for
- 23 political subdivisions with outstanding loans from the fund;
- (C) increasing grant funding from the fund for
- 25 communities with artificial drainage systems; or
- 26 (D) revising the income levels used to determine
- 27 the eligibility for or the amount of a grant or loan from the fund

- 1 for communities with artificial drainage systems.
- 2 (d) The task force shall hold public hearings in coastal and
- B border regions of this state, including hearings in El Paso, the Rio
- 4 Grande Valley, and Corpus Christi.
- 5 SECTION 3. REPORT. Not later than December 21, 2024, the
- 6 task force shall prepare and submit to the board, the speaker of the
- 7 house of representatives, the lieutenant governor, and the governor
- 8 a report that includes recommendations identified by the task
- 9 force.
- 10 SECTION 4. EXPIRATION. The task force is abolished and this
- 11 Act expires January 1, 2025.
- 12 SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect September
- 13 1, 2023.
