- 2 relating to the jurisdiction of county attorneys to file price
- 3 gouging lawsuits in a declared emergency.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 17, Business & Commerce Code, is amended
- 6 by adding Section 17.46a to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 17.46a. COUNTY ATTORNEY AUTHORITY TO FILE ACTION
- 8 REGARDING PRICE GOUGING IN A DECLARED EMERGENCY. A county attorney
- 9 has concurrent jurisdiction with the attorney general to pursue an
- 10 action under Sec. 17.46(b)(27).

- 11 SECTION 2. Section 17.46a, Business & Commerce Code, as
- 12 added by this Act, does not apply to a cause of action that accrued
- 13 before the effective date of this Act. A cause of action that
- 14 accrued before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law
- 15 applicable to the cause of action immediately before that date, and
- 16 that law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 17 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 18 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 19 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 20 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 21 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
