1-21 relating to compensatory time off for certain state employees.
 1-22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
 1-23 SECTION 1. Section 662.005(b), Government Code, is amended
 1-24 to read as follows:
 1-25 (b) Except as provided by Section 662.010, and
 1-26 notwithstanding Section 659.015 or another law, each of the
 1-27 following state employees who is required to work on a national or
 1-28 state holiday that falls on a Saturday or Sunday is entitled to
 1-29 compensatory time off at the rate of one hour for each hour worked
 1-30 on the holiday:
 1-31 (1) an employee of the Department of Family and
 1-32 Protective Services in the statewide intake division who receives
 1-33 reports of abuse or neglect;
 1-34 (2) ~~[a state employee who is]~~ a peace officer
 1-35 commissioned by a state officer or state agency listed under
 1-36 Article 2.12, Code of Criminal Procedure;
 1-37 (3) an employee of the Department of Public Safety
 1-38 who:
 1-39 (A) ~~performs [, or who is employed by the~~
 1-40 ~~Department of Public Safety either to perform]~~ communications or
 1-41 dispatch services related to traffic law enforcement; or
 1-42 (B) is ~~[or as]~~ a public security officer, as that
 1-43 term is defined by Section 1701.001, Occupations Code; or
 1-44 (4) an employee of the Parks and Wildlife Department
 1-45 who performs ~~[, or who is employed by the Parks and Wildlife~~
 1-46 ~~Department to perform]~~ communications and dispatch services to
