8	CERTIFICATION. (a) The board shall establish a dual language
9	immersion bilingual education teaching certificate to provide
10	instruction to high school students in bilingual education programs
11	using a dual language immersion/one-way or two-way program model.
12	(b) To be eligible for a certificate established under this
13	section, a person must:
14	(1) satisfactorily complete the coursework for that
15	certificate in an educator preparation program;
16	(2) perform satisfactorily on the Bilingual Target
17	Language Proficiency Test; and
18	(3) satisfy any other requirements prescribed by the
19	board designed to address specific linguistic and content

(c) The board shall propose rules to allow a person seeking

- 7 through the completion of fewer components, including eliminating a

- 11 SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date
- 12 of this Act, the State Board for Educator Certification shall
- 13 propose rules prescribing requirements for an educator
- 14 certification in dual language immersion bilingual education
- 15 teaching as provided by Section 21.04892, Education Code, as added
- 16 by this Act.
- 17 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
