- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 421.072, Government Code, is amended by 6 adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:
- 7 <u>(d) The governor may allocate available federal and state</u>
- 8 grants and other funding related to homeland security to a local
- 9 governmental entity or a nonprofit entity for:
- 10 (1) expenses incurred by the entity to provide
- 11 <u>humanitarian assistance to unaccompanied minors and families</u>,
- 12 including expenses incurred for public safety, medical care,
- 13 <u>shelter, transportation, and nourishment; and</u>
- 14 (2) the humane processing of the remains of
- 15 undocumented migrants.
