4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 26, Education Code, is amended by adding
6	Section 26.016 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 26.016. PARENT VOLUNTEERS. (a) In this section,
8	"parent volunteer" means a parent or guardian of a student enrolled
9	in the school district.
10	(b) Each school district shall adopt a policy to allow and
11	encourage parent volunteers at each campus in the district. The
12	<pre>policy:</pre>
13	(1) must allow a parent volunteer to volunteer on the
14	campus in the district in which the parent volunteer's child is
15	<pre>enrolled;</pre>
16	(2) must require the parent volunteer to provide the
17	documents needed for the district to perform a criminal history
18	background check as provided by Section 22.0835;

- 19 (3) must require the school district to develop and
- implement training for parent volunteers that: 20
- (A) ensures parent volunteers do not interfere 21
- 22 with instructional time; and
- 23 (B) includes guidelines for parent volunteers to
- 24 follow while at a campus in the district;

- 1 (4) must require a parent volunteer to complete the
- 2 training described by Subdivision (3) before the parent volunteer
- 3 is allowed to volunteer;
- 4 (5) may only prohibit parent volunteers from being
- 5 present on the campus in the district in which the parent
- 6 volunteer's child is enrolled during the administration of a
- 7 standardized test;
- 8 (6) may not prohibit parent volunteers from
- 9 volunteering if the parent volunteer has filed a grievance or

- 20 SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date
- 21 of this Act, each school district shall adopt a policy required by
- 22 Section 26.016, Education Code, as added by this Act.
- SECTION 3. This Act applies beginning with the 2023-2024
- 24 school year.
- 25 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 26 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 27 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
