## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to authorizing certain cities to change the date on which

- 3 their general election for officers is held.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 41.0052, Election Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsection (c) and adding Subsection (f) to read as
- 7 follows:
- 8 (c) A home-rule city may implement  $\underline{a}$  [the] change authorized
- 9 by this section [Subsection (a)] or provide for the election of all
- 10 members of the governing body at the same election through the
- 11 adoption of a resolution. The change contained in the resolution
- 12 supersedes a city charter provision that requires a different
- 13 general election date or that requires the terms of members of the
- 14 governing body to be staggered.
- 15 (f) The governing body of a city with a population of 9,000
- 16 or less, located predominantly in a county that has a total area of
- 17 less than 4,800 square miles, that has adopted a council-manager
- 18 form of government and that holds its general election for officers
- 19 on a date other than the November uniform election date may, not
- 20 <u>later than December 31, 2024, change the date on which it holds its</u>
- 21 general election for officers to the November uniform election
- 22 date. Subsections (b), (c), and (d) apply to the change of an
- 23 <u>election date under this subsection</u>. This subsection expires
- 24 January 1, 2025.

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1 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
